



Pupil Premium Expenditure

Pupil Premium Funding is for those pupils who are identified as FSM (Free School Meals) at any point in the last six years (known as Ever 6 FSM), LAC (Looked After Children) who have been looked after continuously for more than six months and children of service personnel. Pupil Premium is 'additional funding' allocated to the above pupils with the aim of supporting and closing the attainment gap between these pupils and their peers locally and nationally.
