

Art and Design – Key Stage One

Developing, planning and communicating ideas

- I can use tone, texture and colour to communicate.
- I can draw a simple observational drawing.
- I can draw a picture of the correct size & proportion for the size of the paper.
- I can hold and use an appropriate sized paint brush.

Working with tools, equipment, materials and components to make quality products

- I can select and use an appropriate sized paint brush.
- I can use some printing techniques. (I can do simple printing)
- I know and can explain which tools I will use.

Evaluating processes and products

- I can describe how something works.
- I can talk about my own work and things that other people have done.
- I can offer ideas to improve my work.
- I am beginning to work collaboratively.
- I can give reasons for materials I have selected.

Breadth of study

Drawing & Painting

Drawing

- I can draw lines of different shapes and thickness. I can use different grades of pencil in my drawings. (I can use a pencil and crayons to draw)
- I can use charcoal and pastels.
- I am able to create different tones using light and dark.
- I can use drawings to show patterns and texture.
- I can draw a self-portrait (using line and colour).

Painting

- I can use and mix paint to create all the secondary colours.
- (I can use primary and secondary colours)
- I can choose the appropriate thickness of a brush.
- I am able to make tints by adding white and black.

Printing & Sketch Books

Printing

- I can create a print using pressing, rolling, rubbing and stamping. (I can use sponges, vegetables and fruit to print)
- I can print onto paper and textile.
- Create a repeating pattern.

Sketch books

- I am beginning to use a sketchbook to record simple ideas and drawings.
- I can use a sketch book to begin to sort my ideas.

Artists

- I can talk about the work of different artists.
- I can compare different types of art.
- I can link my own art to other artist's styles.

3D/Collage & Textiles

3D

- I can cut, roll and coil materials such as clay, dough or plasticine.
- I can add texture by using tools.
- I am able to add line and shape to my work.

Textiles

- I can choose fabrics to work with to create texture and colour.
- I can sort and group threads and fabrics by colour and texture.

Collage

- I am able to create individual and group collages.
- I can use different kinds of materials in my collage.
- I can cut and tear paper and card for my collages.
